### **RATIONALE FOR CHANGE**

- Educational needs of the student
- Equity of access
- Limited enrolment
- Labour intensive for staff and parents
- Efficient use of human resources
- Times have changed technology can assist

## **MAJOR CHANGES**

- Name of policy
- Two choices only
- Online application
- Application 11 months in advance of entry point
- Waitlist in effect for one year only (transition plan will include a grandfathering of the current waitlist)
- Langley residents first
- Possible random draw process
- 48 hours to accept a placement



### **PRIORITY ORDER FOR INTAKE**

- 1. Siblings of Langley residents
- 2. Langley residents
- 3. Siblings of non-resident students
- 4. Non-resident students



### **RANDOM DRAW EXAMPLE**

#### 44 French Immersion total spaces

12 siblings of Langley resident FI Program students

#### • Scenario 1: 32 remaining spaces

- 28 Langley students on the waitlist are all enrolled
- 10 Out-of-District siblings triggers a random draw to fill the four remaining spaces

### • Scenario 2: 32 remaining spaces

• 40 Langley students on the waitlist triggers a random draw to fill the 32 spaces

### **RANDOM DRAW**

- \*Note: Random draw process could be triggered at different stages in the priority order depending on availability of seats
  - Surrey
  - Abbotsford
    - Burnaby
  - Richmond
  - Vancouver
    - Delta
  - Coquitlam
  - New Westminster
  - North Vancouver
  - West Vancouver



### **TRANSITIONING OVER TIME**

Grandfathering of Waitlist

- Eases concerns for current applicants
- Could take several years depending on program
