









#### Proposal A: Considerations

- Langley Meadows and RC Garnett will be over capacity
  - Including portables\*
- RC Garnett has a detached catchment
- Willoughby Elementary not at capacity until 2028
- Richard Bulpitt over capacity by 2020







#### Proposal B: Considerations







#### Proposal C: Considerations

- Langley Meadows at capacity in 2018
- No natural population divide for the Willoughby West (Routley) area
- RC Garnett drops below 400 students by 2019
- Richard Bulpitt will have capacity challenges in 2019





- Richard Bulpitt is over capacity by 2020



#### Proposal E: Catchment Map





#### Staff Recommendation (Proposal E)

- Requires the **possible** use of James Anderson as an satellite campus to RC Garnett for approximately 3 years
  - Staff will need to work on logistics and details
    - Potentially effective 2017 (use of James Anderson)
      - Potentially until 2020
      - James Anderson has 6 classrooms (there is room for portables on site)
    - Need to determine configuration
      - Feedback
    - Need to determine who attends James Anderson
      - Feedback
    - Subject to Board approval in June\*\*



### Staff Recommendation (Proposal E)

- ◆ Allows Langley Meadows, Lynn Fripps, RC Garnett (including JA) to be in the mid 400's range long term
- ◆ Moves the enrolment pressure for Richard Bulpitt to 2020 or 2021 with portables
- Moves the enrolment pressure for Willoughby Elementary further into the future
- Five-Year Capital Plan reflects the need to purchase additional land for a new elementary school
- RC Garnett expansion currently in the Five-Year Capital Plan
  - Conversations with Ministry staff are ongoing



## Staff Recommendation (Proposal E)

#### Richard Bulpitt

- Current Kindergarten and Grade 1 students (2015-16) at RBES, but living in the proposed Willoughby and RCG/James
   Anderson catchments would need to attend Willoughby and RCG/James Anderson Elementary in 2017
- Students in Grades 2 and 3 (2015/16 school year) can remain at RBES
  - Need to determine information on the upcoming siblings

#### Willoughby Slope

 Students in 2017/18 in grades 4 and 5 can remain at their current schools
