





Report on Achievement

January 2015

"Overall the District is concerned that it has lost a significant amount of momentum with respect to its primary reading results. Despite improvements realized with the June 2011 Grade 1 cohort, the District is concerned that 274 students left Grade 3 still not reading at grade level. The District is also concerned that of those 274 students, 155 of them were not yet meeting grade level expectations. The District is committed to having all students reading at grade level by the end of Grade 3."
